Dear CWRA member

You may have received a letter or email recently from a Richard Walker, claiming to be organising an AGM for CWRA on March 9th, to be held via ZOOM

Richard Walker has no authority to organise any CWRA AGM

He was not elected at the last AGM, held in 2019. He has not been voted onto the Committee, **He has no authority to speak for CWRA**

He is self-appointed, being apparently supported by a small group set up by Lynne Rothberg. She was banned from the Committee, along with her husband and Yasmin Dubash for totally unacceptable behaviour at a committee meeting last September.

The AGM that Richard Walker is purporting to organise is unconstitutional, and would have no power to make any decisions about CWRA. It is also not a proper AGM at all.

CWRA has issued a statement about the 2020 AGM, and plans for a 2021 AGM.

Beyond the above reasons, the AGM that Richard Walker is advertising is not proper because:

- 1 – The Constitution does not permit an AGM to be held remotely, eg via ZOOM
- 2 – We consider it would be unfair to do so for the reasons explained in our statement above
- 3 – There can be no requirement to register in advance in order to attend an AGM
- 4 – There can be no requirement to provide an email address in order to attend an AGM
- 5 – There can be no requirement to provide a telephone number in order to attend an AGM
There is a likelihood that phone would be used to improperly lobby members in advance
- 6 – The Agenda is improper. Any AGM must cover the entire period since the previous AGM
Any AGM must allow Matters Arising from that report
Any AGM must include Any Other Business - a chance for Members to raise any issues they wish
Any AGM must allow members to propose motions submitted in advance
- 7 – Anyone standing for the Committee or to be an officer must be nominated and seconded
It appears that Richard Walker and friends wish to vet people in advance – they can't do this

It is entirely up to you whether you wish to attend this invalid AGM which is being proposed

Should you attend, you are urged to raise its legitimacy, and also the suitability of any of the five named persons overleaf to be involved in the running of CWRA
